Try out our new online language learning program, Mango Languages. Mango replaces TELL ME MORE and offers additional languages in an easy to use format for all computer platforms.

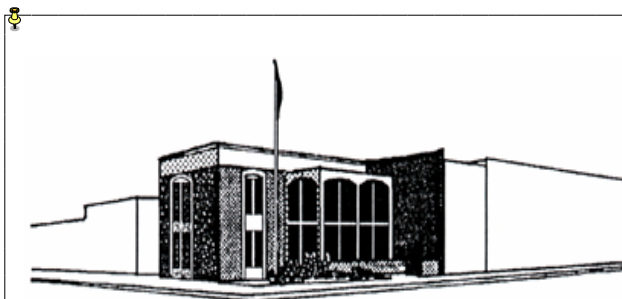
