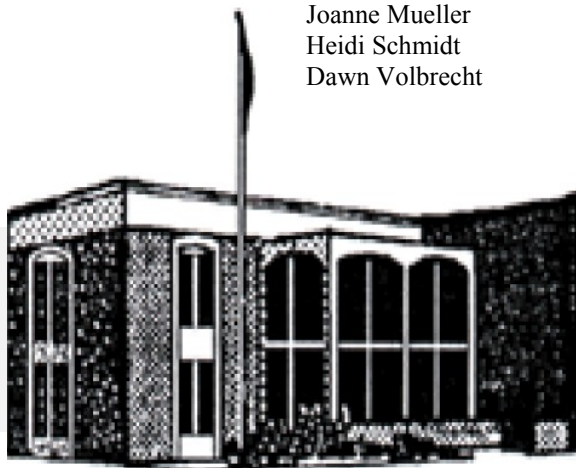


New Materials
